The Sign of the Cross: By the sign of the cross deliver us from our enemies, you who are our God. In the name of the Father of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

The Apostles' Creed: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of the saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

The Our Father (For the good intentions of the Holy Father): Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil.

The Hail Mary (For Faith, Hope, and Charity): Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen

Glory Be to the Father: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Joyful

1. Gabriel announces God's incarnation through the Blessed Virgin Mary
2. Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth
3. Jesus, our savior, is born of the Virgin Mary in a stable
4. Jesus is presented in the Temple
5. Jesus is found discussing with the elders in the Temple

Light

1. John baptizes Jesus in the Jordan River
2. Jesus manifests his first miracle at the Wedding in Cana
3. Jesus proclaims of the Kingdom of God inviting people to conversion
4. Jesus is transfigured at Mount Tabor
5. Jesus institutes the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist during The Last Supper.

Sorrowful

1. Jesus prays in agony in the Garden of Gethsemane
2. Jesus is scourged at the pillar
3. Jesus is crowned with Thorns
4. Jesus carries his cross to Calvary
5. Jesus dies on the cross for our salvation

Glorious

1. Jesus rises from the dead after three days
2. Jesus ascends into heaven in the presence of his eleven apostles
3. The Holy Spirit descends upon the Blessed Virgin and the Apostles
4. God assumes Mary into heaven
5. God crowns Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth
